

All prophesy in the Word of God shall be fulfilled. The prophesy of **Psalms 22:15** My strength is dried up like a potsherd; and my tongue cleaveth to my jaws; and thou hast brought me into the dust of death. and **Psalms 69:21** They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink. These two prophesies were fulfilled with the words of the LORD Jesus upon the cross “I thirst”. All things that have been ordained of God shall be fulfilled.

John 19:28 After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, saith, **I thirst.** 29 Now there was set a vessel full of vinegar: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put *it* upon hyssop, and put *it* to his mouth. 30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, he said, **It is finished:** and he bowed his head, and gave up the ghost.

Beloved Jesus took of the cup of the cross according to the will of God; all who walk this earth will thirst and will seek to have their thirst quenched. The LORD God will offer a cup and you will make a choice. This cup will surely be offered and the word of God fulfilled as it was on the cross. What cup shall you choose; the Cup of the LORD or the cup of the world; the cup of blessings or the cup of wrath and damnation?

What Shall I Get You To Drink?

An often question we are asked when we go out to dine by the person serving us is “What may I get you to drink”? In reality this is a question that the LORD will ask every person that has lived upon this earth and reached the age of accountability. The LORD asks each of us “What cup shall ye drink of? Our eternity depends on our answer to that question. What shall ye drink?

The Cup of the Wrath of God

Psalms 11:6 Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: *this shall be* the portion of their cup.

Everyone that does not accept the salvation of the LORD Jesus Christ shall have their portion of God’s wrath poured upon them; they will surely drink of this cup. The wicked are now trying to destroy the very foundations of society; truth, justice, love, compassion, free thought and basic human decency. It is a mixture of their own making; their rebellion and wickedness has made for them a drink of damnation to their soul.

They fill their cup with unrighteousness and speak evil of dignities.

2Peter 2:10 But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous *are they*, selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.

Their drink shall be filled with the wrath of God. The LORD asks what shall I get you to drink?

Psalms 75:8 For in the hand of the LORD *there is* a cup, and the wine is red; it is full of mixture; and he poureth out of the same: but the dregs thereof, all the wicked of the earth shall wring *them* out, and drink *them*.

Psalms 11:6 Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: *this shall be* the portion of their cup.

This cup is in the hand of the LORD and it is full; full of the sins of every unrepentant soul. Each will surely drink of the mixture of their sins. It shall be drunk down to the very last drop (dregs). The same shall be poured out by the very hand of God. The LORD asks what shall I get you to drink?

Isaiah 51:17 Awake, awake, stand up, O Jerusalem, which hast drunk at the hand of the LORD the cup of his fury; thou hast drunken the dregs of the cup of trembling, and wrung *them* out.

Revelation 14:10 The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

The cup of trembling at the hand of the LORD shall be the drink of those that have rejected the LORD and of this cup they shall drink it in full; this time the cup is without mixture but pure in fury and judgement; for they shall receive the full measure of the fury of God. The LORD asks what shall I get you to drink?

Jeremiah 25:15 For thus saith the LORD God of Israel unto me; Take the wine cup of this fury at my hand, and cause all the nations, to whom I send thee, to drink it. 16 And they shall drink, and be moved, and be mad, because of the sword that I will send among them.

Jeremiah 51:7 Babylon *hath been* a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.

There will be no avoiding this cup for it is at the hand of the LORD and it is measured according to the sins of those that shall drink it. As the sins of Israel stirred up the wrath and fury of God; and judgment was poured out upon them by the hand of God; using the sword of the Babylonians; so shall the coming judgment upon the world be poured out upon the unbelieving and all who have forsaken the LORD and have drunk of the wine of fornication.

In these last days; the antichrist and the angels of the apocalypse will be God Almighty's instrument of judgement and the LORD's cup will be full of the sins of those that have rejected the Lamb slain and have become drunk with the Babylonian\Luciferian world system. It is a cup of judgement that only the LORD can pour; for He alone is the righteous judge that will judge.

Psalms 9:7 But the LORD shall endure for ever: he hath prepared his throne for judgment. 8 And he shall judge the world in righteousness, he shall minister judgment to the people in uprightness.

The LORD asks what shall I get you to drink?

The Cup of Blessing and the Drink of Life (for the Believer)

Psalms 23:5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

For the believer our cup shall run over with the blessings of our LORD; it is a cup of anointing and it is a cup of peace in the presence of our enemies. It is filled with the Love of our LORD and His redemption; it is poured out in full measure to the believing that accept and love Him.

Psalms 116:13 I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD.

The believer shall drink of the cup of Salvation and it is full of the living water from which springs forth eternal life. It is a cup but once filled and shall never be empty. It is a cup filled with never ending peace and joy. **John 4:14** *But whosoever drinketh of the water that I shall give him shall never thirst; but the water that I shall give him shall be in him a well of water springing up into everlasting life.*

The believer shall drink of the cup of the LORD; blessed by our Saviour. Think of how wonderful it is to drink of this cup blessed by the very words of God and given by His gracious hand. As those which choose the cup of the fury of God filled with their sins; the cup of the believer is filled with everlasting forgiveness. The LORD asks what shall I get you to drink?

Matthew 26:27 And he took the cup, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, **Drink ye all of it; 28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.**

The believer shall drink of the cup of which no one could give but the LORD himself. It is a unique cup of which can only be poured and offered by the LORD; for no other is worthy and no other could fill the cup; but the LORD.

We do well to consider that before we could drink of the cup of salvation the LORD Jesus had first to drink of the cup of the wrath of God; full of God's anger and the sins of the world; it is a cup that the LORD drank in our place. He consumed the cup of wrath; that we might have the cup of blessing and salvation.

Oh how much He loves us and how much we should love Him above all else; for He drank the poison of sin for us; because He was faithful to the will of God.

Matthew 26:39 And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, *O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.*

John 18:11 Then said Jesus unto Peter, *Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which my Father hath given me, shall I not drink it?*

2 Corinthians 5:21 For he hath made him *to be* sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

The cup of the sweetness of salvation that the believer may drink of is possible only because the LORD Jesus drank the cup of bitterness filled with the sins of the world and the wrath of God. It did not pass from the LORD but He drank it in obedience to the Will of God; oh what we could do for the Kingdom of God if we too would be obedient to God's Will in our lives.

What Cup Shall You Drink?

Beloved you cannot drink of the Cup of God and the Cup of the World.

1 Corinthians 10:21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.

Depending upon which cup you choose you will drink the consequences of that cup; blessings or cursing, life or death, heaven or hell. What cup shall you choose; the cup of living water or the cup of the wrath of God? For all those that will reject the LORD and choose Satan you shall receive a double portion and a double cup from the LORD.

Revelation 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

The unbeliever shall drink bitterly of the wine of the wrath of God and it shall not be diluted but full of strength and the wrath of God shall be mixed in His cup of indignation and it shall be poison to the soul and a cup of everlasting torment. Which cup will you choose? The LORD asks what may I get you to drink?
